

GLEBE BIA FAÇADE IMPROVEMENT GRANT PROGRAM

GRANT APPLICATION CHECKLIST

Applicants must submit a complete application package. Incomplete applications may not be reviewed.

PART A — BEFORE YOU APPLY (Eligibility Confirmation)

- Property is located within the Glebe BIA boundary
- Applicant is the property owner or an authorized tenant
- All property taxes, utilities, and business licences are current
- Proposed improvements are eligible under the Program Guidelines
- All improvements are visible from the public right-of-way
- No work has started prior to grant approval

PART B — APPLICATION SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Completed Façade Improvement Program Application Form
- Proof of property ownership OR written authorization from the property owner
- Minimum three (3) clear “before” photographs showing:
 - The full building façade
 - The surrounding context
 - Any areas proposed for improvement
- Design drawings or elevations clearly illustrating all proposed façade improvements
- Description of materials, colours, lighting, and architectural features
- Written project description outlining:
 - Nature of the business
 - Scope of façade improvements
 - How the improvements enhance the building and streetscape
- Detailed project budget identifying all anticipated costs
- Itemized contractor quote(s) for the proposed work
- Identification of any required City permits
- Copies of permit applications, if available at time of submission

PART C — AFTER APPROVAL (Required for Reimbursement)

Do not begin work until you have received written approval and signed the Grant Agreement.

- Grant Agreement signed prior to commencement of work
- All required permits obtained before construction
- Project completed in accordance with the approved scope of work
- Minimum three (3) photographs of the completed façade improvements
- Copies of paid invoices and receipts
- Final inspection documentation, if applicable

IMPORTANT NOTES

- Costs incurred before grant approval are not eligible for reimbursement
- Approval of an application does not guarantee funding
- Funding is subject to available program funds and compliance with program guidelines
